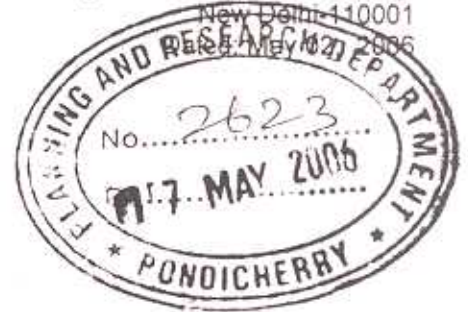

Subject - Annual Plan 2006-07 - Approved Outlay - Pondicherry

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the discussion held in the Planning Commission at the level of the Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission with the Chief Minister of your UT Administration on 04.01.2006 wherein the outlay of Rs.1410 crores proposed by your UT Administration for Annual Plan 2006-07 was agreed to.

2 The scheme of financing agreed outlays is given at Annexure I.

3 A statement showing the distribution of agreed plan outlay among different heads and sub-heads of development is enclosed. The earmarked outlays have also been indicated therein.


4 The agreed outlay of the Annual Plan 2006-07 for the UT of Pondicherry is Rs.1410 crores. The UT Administration has earmarked Rs.178.73 crores for Special Component Plan (SCP) (Rs.138.72 crores for general programmes plus Rs.40.01 crores for infrastructure development through HUDCO), which works out to 12.68% of the total outlay. The SC population is 16.19%. As per the guidelines of the Planning Commission, outlays to be earmarked for SCs should be Rs.228.42 crores. The shortfall of Rs.49.69 crores in the SCP outlay should be provided by obtaining supplementary grants at the earliest. This will be by re-appropriation within the overall approved Plan outlay of Rs.1410 crores. Also, Secretary, Social Welfare Department should be vested with the authority of planning for the outlay under SCP.

5 I am directed to invite your attention to the procedure for sending adjustment proposals and to request you to send the adjustment proposals for the Annual Plan 2006-07, if any, together with appropriate justification, before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2006.

6 The plan programmes need to be monitored closely with a view to achieving the financial and physical targets.

Note SC population constitute 16.2% of the total population in the Union Territory of Pondicherry. SCP is prepared as an integral part of Annual Plan.

Rs 178.73 crores have been earmarked for the development of SCs which is 12.68% of the total outlay.

The UT Admn. will have to allocate an additionality Rs.49.69 crores for SCP at RE stage.

\$\$ As these programmes are implemented in the coastal belts they will benefit largely fishermen community.

However, it includes Rs 40.01 crores earmarked for SCP for tsunami related infrastructure development through HUDCO.
